Volunteers needed for Bassett Island cleanup, May 8

The Pocasset Water Quality Coalition and the listed neighborhood associations are cosponsoring a cleanup of the Bassett Island shoreline on Saturday, May 8. They will be supported by the Bourne Shore & Harbors Committee and the Department of Natural Resources. This heavily used island has not had a thorough cleanup in seven years. Ferry trips to the island will begin at 8:30 from Barlows Landing. Barlows Landing has very few parking spaces, so volunteers are urged to carpool with friends or neighbors.

Volunteers should dress appropriately, including masks, work gloves and waterproof shoes or boots, and if possible, their own PFDs for the ferry ride. They should also bring a refillable water bottle - the Pocasset Water Quality Coalition will provide an Igloo cooler for refills, and will provide individually-packaged snacks.
